Joint-director of an NGO for the development of ethno-tourism in N. Montenegro

This very young NGO has won a 12-month contract with the European Union South Eastern Europe Local Development Fund to show the potential of ethno-tourism and ethno-villages in securing the rural way of life and local economy in several villages in the north-west part of Montenegro. We are looking for a bright and enthusiastic graduate with foreign language skills, a love of nature and a thirst for adventure to be a partner in this NGO and help develop this type of tourism in Montenegro. Ideally, should be able to travel easily to this area of Montenegro.

Writing project proposals for USAID in Montenegro

Young graduate of English language required to write project proposals for USAID for future development projects in Montenegro. Projects that have been recent completed include refurbishment of the Maritime Museum in Kotor, widening and improving the roads to Plav and the Prokletije area and developing an ethno-village complex near Pluzine. No work experience in this area is needed, but the applicant must have some general work experience and lots of enthusiasm and ideas for developing the future of this country. Must show ability to work in a team and be able to take the initiative in various situations.

He/she does not need former experience in this sector of the economy, but should be aware of the potential of the media to fulfil the goals of the Association. Should be willing to travel and move around the country at short notice.
